



NEVADA STATE TEAM REQUIREMENTS

(REVISED JANUARY 2026)

TARGET REQUIREMENTS AND RECOGNITION

Section 1. Nevada State Team Requirements

Shooters, to qualify for the Nevada State Team, must have shot a minimum of 1,000 singles, 1,000 handicap, and 500 doubles targets during the target year. Also, shooters must have shot at a minimum of 3 different gun clubs in Nevada or other States during the target year. And shooters must shoot all three Championship Events at the Nevada State shoot. These requirements apply to all shooters including Lady I, Lady II, Sub-Veteran, Veteran, Senior Veteran, Junior Gold, Junior and Sub Junior.

Section 2. Nevada State Team Member Awards

Awards shall be limited to the five shooters in each category who have the highest overall averages across all three trapshooting disciplines: Singles, Handicap, and Doubles. The recognized award categories are Open, Lady I, Lady II, Sub-Junior, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub-Veteran, Veteran, and Senior Veteran. First-time State Team inductees shall receive an embroidered State Team jacket, a Nevada State Team belt buckle, and a Nevada State Team Certificate of Achievement. Second-time inductees, and all subsequent inductees, shall receive a Nevada State Team belt buckle and a Nevada State Team Certificate of Achievement only. State Team jackets shall be awarded only to first-time inductees during their initial year of qualification.
